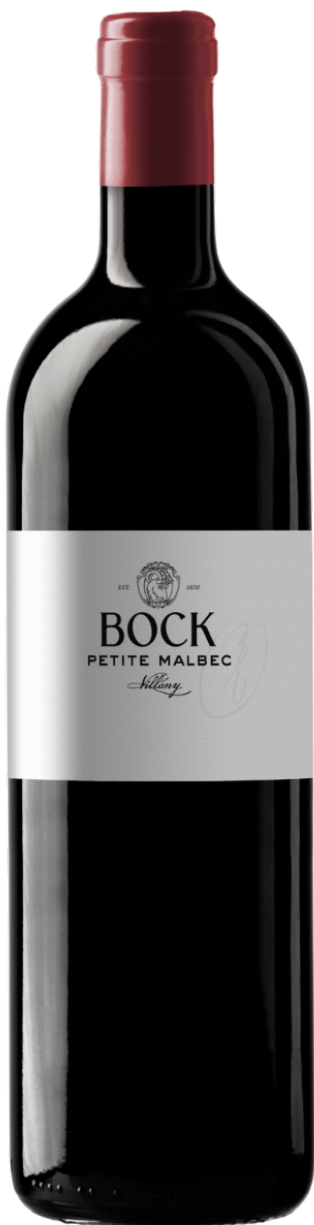




Bock BV Petite Malbec

Tasting notes

The new addition to the BV series is Petite Malbec, whose name indicates the two varieties, Petit Verdo and Malbec. Its color reflects shades of garnet red, and its aroma is dominated by berries, cherries, blueberries, and blackberries. The first sip reveals the aroma of fruit and sweet spices, followed by lively acidity and a firm body. This wine has great aging potential.
