A light red wine made from the produce of the Fekete-hegy vineyard, which after traditional fermentation is matured for six months as the third occupant of an oak barrel. It is characterized by a pale intensity; in its bouquet and taste can be discovered spices and aromas reminiscent of raspberry and strawberries.
