Type: Villány classicus red wine with protected designation of origin (Premium wine)

Tasting notes

A Portugieser from the Jammertal and Ördögárok vineyards, bottled following fermentation and six months of maturation in wooden casks. The longer maturing period extends the wine's lifetime. Crimson in colour with shades of purple, with velvety acids, fruity in flavour while cherry aromas appear in its bouquet. A more complex, spicier wine than is customary in a Portugieser.
